## Word, etc., Indicating Relationship Following Surname

### AACR2, 22.15C

Do <u>not</u> add other titles or terms associated with names entered under surname unless they are required to distinguish between two or more persons with the same name and neither dates nor fuller forms of name are available

e.g., 千宗室十六代 --> Sen, Sōshitsu, ‡d 1956-

## *RDA*, 9.2.2.9.5

Record similar terms [=words, etc., indicating relationship following surnames] (e.g., *Jr.*, *Sr.*, *fils*, *père*) and numbers (e.g., *III*) occurring in languages other than Portuguese following the person's forename or forenames, preceded by a comma.

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Sen, Sōshitsu<u>, **‡**C XVI</u>, **‡**d 1956-

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# **Date Associated with Person**

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# **Profession/Occupation**

## AACR2, 22.19B1

If neither a fuller form of name nor dates are available to distinguish between identical headings of which the entry element is a surname, add a qualifier (e.g., term of honour, term of address, title of position or office, initials of an academic degree, initials denoting membership in an organization) that appears with the name in works by the person or in reference sources. Add the qualifier after the last element of the name.

#### *e.g.*, 小林慧子

[<u>undifferentiated</u> from 小林<u>景</u>子]

## *RDA*, 9.19.1.6

If none of the elements specified under 9.19.1.3 (date of birth and/or death), 9.19.1.4 (fuller form of name), or 9.19.1.5 (period of activity of the person) is available to distinguish one access point from another, add a <u>term</u> <u>indicating</u> the profession or occupation of the person

#### *e.g.*, 小林慧子

# *AACR2*, 24.7A1/24.7B4/24.8B1

Omit from the name of a conference, etc. (including that of a conference entered subordinately), indications of its number, <u>frequency</u>, or year(s) of convocation. (24.7A1)

Add the name of the local place or other location (institution, etc.) in which the conference, etc., was held. ... If the location is part of the name of the conference, etc., do <u>not</u> repeat it. (24.7B4)

Do <u>not</u> add the date and/or location if they are <u>integral parts</u> of the name. (24.8B1)

#### e.g.,

台北當代水墨雙年展 --> Taibei dang dai shui mo .... zhan

日米欧産業協力東京会議 --> Nichi-Bei-Ō Sangyō Kyōryoku <u>Tōkyō</u> Kaigi +d (1986)

### *RDA*, 11.2.2.11/11.3.2.3

Omit from the name of a conference, congress, meeting, exhibition, fair, festival, etc., (including that of a conference, etc., treated as a subordinate body), indications of its number, or year or years of convocation, etc. (11.2.2.11)

Record the name of the local place in which the conference, etc., was held ... (11.3.2.3)

e.g.,

台北當代水墨雙年展 --> Taibei dang dai shui mo <u>shuang</u> <u>nian</u> zhan

日米欧産業協力東京会議 --> Nichi-Bei-O Sangyō Kyōryoku <u>Tōkyō</u> Kaigi ‡d (1986<u>: ‡c Tokyo, Japan</u>)

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# Conference, etc.--cont.

### AACR2, 24.7B4

If the sessions of a conference, etc., were held in two locations, add both names.

If the sessions of a conference, etc., were held in three or more locations, add the <u>first</u> named place <u>followed by etc.</u>

e.g.,

国際シンポジウム「21世紀の国立図書館」

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International Symposium "National Libraries in 21st Century" #d (1996 : #c Tokyo, Japan<u>, and</u> Kyoto, Japan)

国際シンポジウム&ワークショップ春樹をめぐる 冒険

--> Kokusai Shinpojūmu & Wākushoppu Haruki o Meguru Bōken ‡d (2006 : ‡c Tokyo, Japan<u>, etc.</u>)

## *RDA*, 11.3.2.3/E.1.2.4

If the conference was held in more than one place record the names of each of the places in which it was held. (11.3.2.3) Separate multiple locations by a semicolon. (E.1.2.4)

## Uniform Title for Individual Book of the Bible

### AACR2, 25.18A1

Enter a book of the Catholic or Protestant canon as a subheading of the appropriate <u>Testament</u>.

*e.g.*, 約伯傳

uniform title: Bible. <u>+p O.T.</u> +p Job. +I Chinese

## *RDA*, 6.23.2.9.2

For books of the Catholic or Protestant canon, record the brief citation form of the Authorized Version as a subdivision of the preferred title for the <u>Bible</u>.

*e.g.*, 約伯傳

expression preferred title: Bible. +p Job. +l Chinese

[no more intervening "O.T." or "Old Testament"]

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# Multiple Languages

### AACR2, 25.5C1

If an item is in two languages, name <u>both</u>. If one of the languages is the original language, name it second. Otherwise, name the languages in the following order: English, French, German, Spanish, Russian, other languages in alphabetic order of their names in English. If an item is in three or more languages, use <u>Polyglot</u> unless the original work is in three or more languages (e.g., a multilateral treaty), in which case give all the languages in the order specified above.

*e.g.*, 金剛經譯本集成

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Tripitaka. ‡p Sūtrapitaka. ‡p Prajnāpāramitā. ‡p Vajracchedikā. ‡l <u>Polyglot</u>

## *RDA*, 6.11.1.4

If a single expression of a work involves more than one language, record <u>each</u> of the languages.

*e.g.*, 金剛經譯本集成

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Tripițaka. ‡p Sūtrapițaka. ‡p Prajñāpāramitā. ‡p Vajracchedikā. ‡l <u>Chinese</u>

Tripitaka. +p Sūtrapitaka. +p Prajñāpāramitā. +p Vajracchedikā. +l <u>English</u>

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## Libretto

#### AACR2/LCRI, 21.28A1, Alternative

Enter a libretto under the heading appropriate to the <u>musical work</u>.

e.g.,

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八月雪:三幕九場歌劇/ 編導[libretto, direction], 高行健;作曲,許舒亞

ME-UT: <u>Xu, Shuya</u>. *‡t* Ba yue xue. *<u>‡s</u> Libretto* 

## *RDA*, 6.27.1.2/6.27.4.2

If one person, family, or corporate body is responsible for <u>creating the work</u>, construct the authorized access point representing the work by combining (in this order):

a) the authorized access point representing that person, family, or corporate body ...

b) the preferred title for the work ... (6.27.1.2)

Construct a <u>variant</u> access point representing one or more librettos or other texts that have been used in specific musical works by combining in this order:

a) the authorized access point representing the <u>composer</u> of the musical work or musical works ... (6.27.4.2)

#### e.g.,

八月雪:三幕九場歌劇/編導 [libretto, direction], 高 行健;作曲,許舒亞

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authorized access point: <u>Gao, Xingjian</u>. ‡t Ba yue xue

## Selections

## AACR2, 25.9A

Use the collective title <u>Selections</u> for items consisting of three or more works in various forms, or in one form if the person created works in one form only, and for items consisting of extracts, etc., from the works of one person.

*e.g.,* 방 기중 저작집 -->

Pang, Ki-jung. ‡t Selections. ‡f 2010

## *RDA*, 6.2.2.10.3, Alternative

Instead of (or in addition to) recording the preferred title for each of the works in the compilation, record a <u>conventional collective title</u> as instructed under 6.2.2.10.1 or 6.2.2.10.2, as applicable, followed by *Selections*.

#### until PCC Day One for RDA Authority Records:

- in <u>bibliographic</u> records: if SAR found, either coded AACR2 or RDA, use that form in both RDA and AACR2 bibliographic records
- in LC/NACO <u>Authority</u> File:
  - if AACR2 SAR:
    - leave it as is
    - do not create separate RDA SAR
  - if *RDA* SAR:
    - leave it as is
    - do not create separate AACR2 SAR
  - if no corresponding SAR, but AACR2 NAR for the creator:
    - while preparing RDA bib., do not create new RDA or hybrid SAR
    - while preparing AACR2 bib., create new AACR2 SAR
  - if no corresponding SAR, but *RDA* NAR for the creator:
    - while preparing RDA bib., create new RDA SAR
    - while preparing AACR2 bib., do not create new AACR2 or hybrid SAR
    - if neither corresponding SAR nor NAR for the creator:
      - while preparing *RDA* bib., create new *RDA* NAR and SAR
      - while preparing AACR2 bib., create new AACR2 NAR and SAR

## Selections--cont.

## *LCRI*, 25.10, 2)

Consider that the <u>title</u> is adequate in all other cases.

e.g.,

- 100 1\_ Koike, Masayo, ‡d 1959-
- 245 10 文字の導火線 / **+**c 小 池昌代.
- 245 10 Moji no dōkasen / ‡c Koike Masayo.

# *LCPS*, 6.2.2.10.3, Alternative

Instead of recording the preferred title for each of the works in the compilation, record a conventional collective title followed by "Selections."

e.g.,

- 100 1\_\_Koike, Masayo, ‡d 1959-
- 240 10 Essays. +k Selections
- 245 10 文字の導火線 / ‡c 小池昌 代.
- 245 10 Moji no dōkasen / ‡c Koike Masayo.
- 500 \_\_\_ Essays.

## Date Associated with the Person--進士

### AACR2, 22.17A

Add a person's <u>dates</u> (birth, death, <u>etc.</u>) in the form given below as the last element of a heading if the heading is otherwise identical to another. ... <u>chin shih</u> ... Date at which a Chinese literary degree was conferred

*e.g.*, 劉春霖

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Liu, Chunlin, ‡d jin shi 1904

## RDA, 9.3.4.3

If the person's date of <u>birth</u> and date of <u>death</u> are both <u>unknown</u>, record a date or range of dates indicative of the person's period of activity ... jin shi\_ ... Date at which a Chinese literary degree was conferred

*e.g.*, 劉春霖

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Liu, Chunlin, ‡d <u>1872-1944</u>

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## Person of Religious Vocation Other than Pope/Bishop/etc.

### *LCRI*, 22.16D

Add a title, term of address, etc., to persons of religious vocation entered under given name, etc., only if the title, term of address, etc., appears with the name in the chief sources of information in items by the person or in reference sources if the person is not an author.

Ignore Japanese titles of priests unless they are fixed as an integrated part of the name.

e.g., 親鸞聖人 --> Shinran, ‡d 1173-1263

## *RDA*, 9.4.1.8

For a person of religious vocation other than one covered by the instructions given under 9.4.1.6 (popes) or 9.4.1.7 (bishops, etc.) whose given name is recorded as the first element in the preferred name, record the title, term of address, etc., in the language in which the title was conferred or in the language used in the country in which the person resides. [no exception provision in LCPS]

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## Treaty between 2 National Governments

### AACR2, 21.35A1

under ... the heading for the government whose catalogue entry heading (see 24.3E) is <u>first in English alphabetic order</u>.

*e.g.*, 黃埔條約

> work cat.: Correspondance diplomatique chinoise relative aux négociations du Traité de Whampoa conclu <u>entre la</u> <u>France et la Chine</u> le 24 octobre 1844

China. ‡t Treaties, etc. ‡g France, ‡d 1844 Oct. 24

## *RDA*, 6.29.1.15

the authorized access point representing the government named first in resources embodying the work or in reference sources, formulated according to the guidelines and instructions given under 11.13.1 ...

If there is no consistency in the order in which the governments are named in resources embodying the work or in reference sources, construct the authorized access point representing the work using the authorized access point representing the government named first in the first resource received, followed by the preferred title for the treaty, etc.

#### e.g.,

#### 黃埔條約

# Local Church, etc.

### *LCRI*, 24.10B

Add to the name of a local church, cathedral, monastery, convent, abbey, temple, mosque, synagogue, etc., the name of the place in which it is located.

*e.g.*, 出雲大社

--> Izumo Taisha <u>(Izumo-shi,</u> <u>Japan)</u>

## *RDA*, 11.13.1.3

Add the name of the place or local ecclesiastical jurisdiction (e.g., parish, Pfarrei) in which a local church, etc., is located, <u>unless</u> the location is clear from the name itself. [no *LCPS* requiring

categorical addition of place]

*e.g.*, 出雲大社 -->

Izumo Taisha

# **Conference NAR**

### *LCRI*, 24.7B

On the name <u>authority</u> <u>record</u> for a conference heading, do <u>not</u> add the number, date, or place to the name when the conference is an ongoing one, even if all the meetings were held in one place ...

e.g., 第七回南原繁シンポジウム NAR to be created anew per AACR2/LCRI

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Nanbara Shigeru Shinpojūmu

## *LCPS*, 11.13.1.1

If an AACR2 name authority record exists for an ongoing conference constructed according to LCRI 24.7B (i.e., the heading for the conference does not include the number, date, or place of any one specific conference), use the AACR2 form as the basis for making additions to the name in bibliographic records for individual conferences. If there is no AACR2 authority record for an ongoing conference and the conference is being cataloged as a monograph, the RDA authority record for the conference would include all appropriate qualifiers (e.g., number, date, place).

## AACR2/LCRI, 21.17B1

If a work consists of reproductions of the works of an artist and text about the artist and/or the works reproduced, enter under the heading appropriate to the <u>text if</u> the person who wrote it is represented as author in the <u>chief</u> <u>source of information</u> of the item being catalogued. (*AACR2*) <u>Otherwise</u>, enter the catalog under the heading for the <u>artist</u>. (*LCRI*)

e.g.,

the authorized access point representing the person, family, or body responsible for the <u>commentary, etc.</u>
