 - as per BSR metadata application profile, p. 19

040-|e

- 040 __ |a DLC |b eng |c DLC |e rda

– should now read instead:

040 __ |a DLC |b eng |e rda |c DLC

as per BSR metadata application profile, p. 19:

Always place \$e rda directly after the language of cataloging (\$b).

245

- 245: title proper from t.p.; parallel title from t.p. verso--both recorded under 245
 - as per *RDA*, 2.3.3.2:
Take parallel titles proper from any source within the resource.

245- | b, 880- | b, 246

- 245- | b, 880- | b, and 246: inaccuracies not in resource (resource carries words correctly spelt)
 - should instead read:
 - Eearthquake --> Eearthquake
 - higer --> higher
 - as per *RDA*, 2.3.1.4:

Transcribe a title as it appears on the source of information. Apply the general guidelines on transcription given under 1.7.

Inaccuracies

- digression: WHEN inaccuracy indeed found in resource --> *RDA* , 1.7.9

When instructed to transcribe an element as it appears on the source of information, transcribe an inaccuracy or a misspelled word as it appears on the source, except where instructed otherwise.
... If the inaccuracy appears in a title [of a monograph], record a corrected form of the title as a variant title (see 2.3.6) if it is considered to be important for identification or access.

 - as per BSR metadata application profile, pp. 7-9:
264 with 2nd indicator specified and no longer 260 with 2nd indicator left blank

300- | a

- 300 __ |a iv, 232 pages

— as per *RDA*, B.5.11:

Generally do not abbreviate words in elements other than those covered under B.5.1 and B.5.3–B.5.9.

300- | b

- 300- | b illustrations
 - although some in colour--colour content is not a core element (*cf. RDA, 7.17*)

300-|c

- 300-|c 21 cm.

– *RDA*, 3.5.1.3:

... using the metric symbol *cm* [no longer: cm.]

BUT

- *LC-PCC PS*, 1.7.1, Punctuation at the End of MARC Fields 245, 246-247, 250, 264, 300, 310/321, 362, 490, 4, sentence 2:

When a record has a 490 field, insure that field 300 ends in a period.

336-338

- 336 __ |a text |2 rdacontent
 - as per *RDA*, 6.9.1.3
- 337 __ |a unmediated |2 rdamedia
 - as per *RDA*, 3.2.1.3
- 338 __ |a volume |2 rdacarrier
 - as per *RDA*, 3.3.1.3

546

- should add: 546 ____ | a Japanese.
 - 245--Japanese title proper and English parallel title; but, language used to express the content of the resource is Japanese alone (no 041) --> 546
 - as per *LC-PCC PS*, 7.12:
CORE ELEMENT FOR LC

500

- may add 500 on the source of parallel title proper
 - as per *RDA*, 2.20.2.3, para. 3:
If a parallel title proper is taken from a different source than the title proper, make a note on the source of the parallel title proper if it is considered important.

504

- should add: 504
 - as per *LC-PCC PS*, 7.16.1.3, para. 1, sentence 2:
Routinely consider the following as being important for selection: bibliographies and bibliographical references, discographies, and filmographies, and indexes; ...

505

- should add: 505
 - compilation --> contents note
 - as per *LC-PCC PS*, 25.1:

CORE ELEMENT FOR LC: Related work is a core element for LC for compilations: give a MARC 505 contents note unless the contents are indicated in another part of the description ...
There is no limit on the number of works in the contents note

700 X2

- should add: at least one 700 X2
 - as per *LC-PCC PS*, 25.1:
CORE ELEMENT FOR LC: Related work is a core element for LC for compilations: ... For compilations of works, give an analytical authorized access point for the predominant or first work in the compilation
